Bal Ram Singh, PhD, Singh has been a professor since 1990 and Henry Dreyfus Teacher-scholar since 1997 at UMass Dartmouth (until 2014) and at the Institute of Advanced Sciences (INADS), Dartmouth, Massachusetts. He has been visiting professor at Georgetown University, Harvard Medical School, Yang Ming University (Taiwan), and Jawaharlal Nehru University (India). He is currently the President of the Institute of Advanced Sciences, and also the founder of Prime Bio Inc., a biotechnology based company. Dr. Singh is the Founding Director of the Botulinum Research Center, established in 2003 and currently located at INADS. He is also the Founding Director of the Center for Indic Studies at the University of Massachusetts Dartmouth. He is currently a Fellow of the Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Advanced Study, JNU, New Delhi.
