**1ST LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS OF WAVES
TO DR. S. KALYANARAMAN & DR. CALYAM PRABHAKAR**

Dr. S. Kalyanaraman

Dr. S. Kalyanaraman, is Director, Sarasvati Research Centre engaged in civilization studies for over 40 decades. He has a Ph.D. in Public Administration from the University of the Philippines and D.Litt. from Deccan College, Pune Deemed University. He has retired as a Senior Executive of Asian Development Bank after serving there from 1978 to 1995 and on Indian Railways Accounts Services (IRAS) from 1962 and took voluntary retirement to pursue his Indian Civilization research interests.



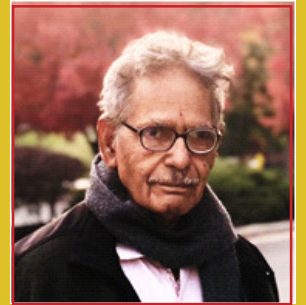
Significance of the Life-time work

He has contributed over 2000 monographs on academia, education and published 26 books including titles: Sarasvati Civilization, Rama Setu (Adam's Bridge), Indian Lexicon, Epigraphia Indus Script in 3 volumes, Wealth Accounting for a Nation—Indus Writing. His main focus of research is on Sarasvati (Indus) Civilization, economic history, script, language and Vedic studies.

He is also active promoting the formation of Indian Ocean Community, National Water Grid and protection of heritage monuments. Dr. Kalyanaraman's pioneering work has completely rewritten the ancient economic history, formation and evolution of Indian languages and polity of the great Indian Civilization.

Dr. Calyam Prabhakar

Dr. C. L. Prabhakar was born in Tadipatri, a temple town in Andhra Pradesh. He has a Science Degree and Postgraduate Degree in Sanskrit from Karnatak University, Dharwar and a Ph.D. degree in Vedic Studies (Shukla Yajurveda). He was previously accorded the honor of *Vedavaridhi*, by Dharma Paripalana Sabha, Bangalore. He retired as a Professor of Sanskrit in 2000. He is a visiting Professor of the Hindu University of America (HUA), Orlando USA. He has been the Chief Editor of the Annual Souvenirs of NVAK by name *VedaGanga* and Editor of the Monthly Bulletin of the NVAK by name *VedaNadaSarit*.



Significance of the Life-time work

In 1994, he founded Nada Vedaadhyayana Kendra (NVAK), in Bangalore to impart knowledge, training and recitation of Veda mantras. In 1998, Prof. Prabhakar inaugurated the Bangalore Chapter of WAVES. Ever since, the spirit, culture, and academics of Vedas, *Sangita* and the *Sanatana Dharma* programs have been held by him under the banner of WAVES and NVAK. He has many publications in the form of Veda, Nada, Epics and Classical Sanskrit. Hundreds of talks organized, thousands of chanting and singing lessons taught, thousands of students engaged, thousands of pages of monthly newsletters and annual journals released, and the list goes on and on.

being brief, yet Algebra was well developed in ancient India and in Vedic times. *Shulva-Sutras* are its most ancient evidence. Number system was there. Bhaskaracharya and other ancient Ganita's Acharyas were referred on top of this science. Dr. Ayush Gupta, Assistant Professor, P.G. Department of Sanskrit, T.M.Bhagalpur University presented on Applications of Vedic Mathematics. In his lecture he described the spiritual aspect of Mathematics. The calculations and counting used in daily life are the utilitarian practices, while the spiritual aspect of Mathematics is ultimate goal. Now a days spiritual aspect is missing, all Mathematicians are running with calculations.

Dr. Gupta described applications of Vedic Mathematics with power point presentation. He explained 14 *Sutras* of Vedic Mathematics. Every *sutra* has four to five applications. All the Applications were described in an articulated way. Finally, Dr. Gupta emphasized on spiritual aspect.. He referred some of the Mathematicians like Baudhayan, Aryabhata, Varahmihir and Shrinivas Ramanujan, who always pointed out the spiritual aspect of equation and calculations.

Thus, it was a successful session sentimentality and academically.

Nation is a collection of groups, organizations and the aggregate of power.

Thus, the Indian perspective says that '*Rashtra*' means a unit, which in itself represents a place and an interconnected eternal culture and eternal stream flowing through it. The Chief Guest, Prof. Shashi Tiwari presented her views on the theme by saying that all the ancient texts mention the nature of the nation—*Shastrena Rakshite Rashtra Shashtra-Charca Pravarte*. Unity in diversity, cultural unity, social unity, religious unity and geographical unity—all these are collective form of all the elements of the nation. Cultural consciousness is the inner aspect of *Rashtriyata* in Indian context. Presiding over the program, Prof. Umakant Yadavji said that the concept of nation is a very relevant subject in the present context.

The concept of nation in Vedic literature refers to the culture of renunciation—*Rashtraaya Swaha, Idam Rashtraaya Idam Na Mama*. Vedic scholar Prof. Prayag

BANGALORE CHAPTER REPORT

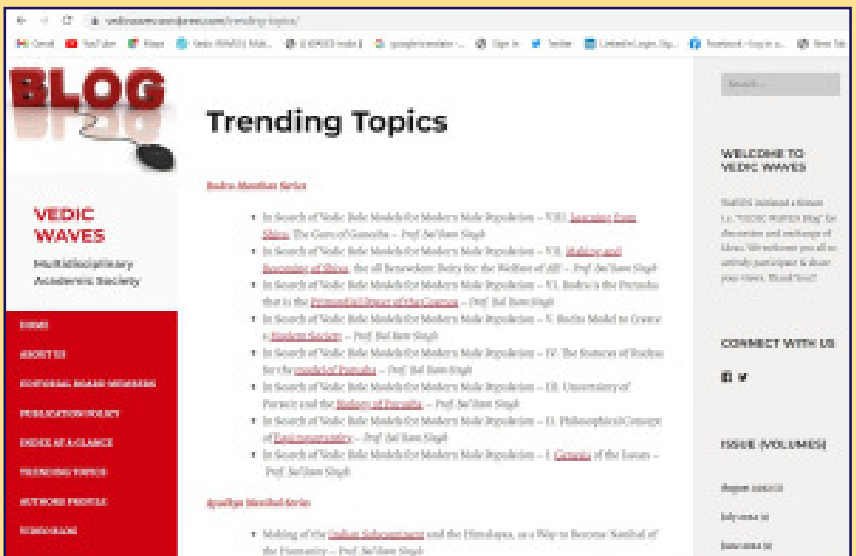
