वेद विमर्श पर एक दिवसीय 'वेद-संगोष्ठी'

24—9—2023 वेद संस्थान, राजौरी गार्डन, दिल्ली



राजौरी गार्डन में स्थित वैदिक ज्ञान को समर्पित संस्था ''वेद संस्थान'' एवं ''बृहत्तर वैदिक अध्ययन परिषद्'' (WAVES) के युवावर्ग (तरुण—तरंग) के संयुक्त तत्त्वावधान में 24—9—2023 को एक दिवसीय 'वेद संगोष्ठी' का आयोजन किया गया। मुख्य रूप से यह संगोष्ठी वेदसंस्थान के संस्थापक वेदों के अध्यायी, वेदप्रचारक, वेद के प्रतिष्ठित विद्वान विद्यानन्द विदेह के सुपुत्र स्व० अभयदेव शर्मा के 90वें जन्मदिवस के अवसर पर आयोजित की गयी थी, जिसमें प्रतिष्ठित विद्वानों, कुलपतियों, सेवानिवृत्त प्राध्यापकों एवं शोध—छात्रों द्वारा उत्साहपूर्वक भाग लिया गया। संगोष्ठी का विषय था; "वेद विमर्श—विविध आयाम"।

इस संगोष्ठी के चार सत्र थे, इन सत्रों में, वर्तमान में वेदसंस्थान के अध्यक्ष आदरणीय श्रीमान् प्रद्युम्न जी ने प्रथम सत्र की अध्यक्षता बहुत ही गम्भीरता से करते हुए सत्र को सम्बोधित भी किया। अगले सत्र के अध्यक्ष डॉ० वेदव्रत आलोक—प्राध्यापक (संस्कृत) दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय दिल्ली, रहे।

इस सम्मेलन में वेव्स की अध्यक्षा प्रो. शशि तिवारी महोदया द्वारा 'वेद व्याख्या की पद्धतियाँ' विषय पर प्रकाश डाला गया। उन्होंने अपने व्याख्यान में बताया कि वेद ज्ञान की शब्दात्मक राशि है। एवं वेद के अर्थों को जानने वाला प्रशंसनीय है। मन्त्रों के अर्थों को समझने के लिए वेदांगों का ज्ञान अवश्य ही होना चाहिए। उन्होंने इसी क्रम में भारतीय प्राचीन भाष्यकारों जैसे—उव्वट, माधव, मुद्गल आदि के विषय में चर्चा की और आधुनिक भाष्यकारों की वेदव्याख्या पद्धति पर भी प्रकाश डाला।

डॉ. उमा आर्या ने द्वारा वेदों में 'गुरु–शिष्य संबन्ध' विषय पर प्रकाश डाला गया। उन्होंने बताया कि वैदिक कालीन शिक्षा



में गुरु शिष्य संबंध विशेष प्रकार के थे, जो अत्यंत मधुर, आत्मीय एवं अनु— करणीय थे। गुरु और शिष्य के मध्य भरोसे और जिम्मेदारी के संबंध हुआ करते थे। गुरु शिष्यों के साथ पुत्रवत् भावना से व्यवहार करते थे। इसी क्रम में तरुण तरंग (वेव्स) की अध्यक्षा एवं एसो. प्रो. डा. करुणा आर्या ने द्वारा वेदार्थ प्रतिपादन में महर्षि दयानन्द जी के



योगदान की विशद चर्चा की।

तरुण तरंग (वेव्स) के पूर्व अध्यक्ष डॉ. धनंजय आचार्य जी द्वारा निघण्टु शब्द का क्या अर्थ है—वह दुनिया का पहला शब्दकोश है यह बताते हुए निघण्टु और निरुक्त के आधार पर वेदमंत्रों का अध्ययन किस प्रकार से किया जाए इस विषय पर प्रकाश डाला। यास्कप्रणीत निरुक्त का आधार निघण्टु है। उन्होंने बताया कि कोशपरम्परा का आरम्भ निघण्टु नामक ग्रन्थ से हुआ एवं निघण्टु वैदिक शब्दों का संग्रह है।

उत्तराखण्ड संस्कृत विश्वविद्यालय, हरिद्वार के कुलपति प्रो. दिनेशचन्द्र शास्त्री जी द्वारा वेदों का एकत्व, त्रित्व, चतुष्टयत्व, अनेकत्व पर विशद व्याख्यान हुआ। उन्होंने बताया कि वेद शब्द के एकवचन प्रयोग से वेद की एकत्व की सिद्धि होती है—सर्वज्ञानमयो हि सः (वेदः)।

वेदत्रयी की सिद्धि में उन्होंने शतपथब्राह्मण का प्रमाण दिया।वेद चतुष्टयत्व का प्रमाण उन्होंने पुरुषसूक्त के मंत्र से दिया ''तस्माद्यज्ञात्सर्वहुत ऋचः सामानि..। (10/90/9; ऋग्वेद)

वेद—अनेकत्व पर उन्होंने कहा कि वेद की शाखाएँ, ब्राह्मण ग्रन्थ, आदि वेद की एक कोटि में ही आते है अतः वेद के अनेकत्व की सिद्धि होती है।

उपसंहार में उन्होंने पुरुषसूक्त के मंत्र का आश्रय लेकर वेद की संख्या चार ही निश्चित की।

श्रीलालबहादुर संस्कृत विश्वविद्यालय के प्रो. देवेंद्र मिश्र का व्याख्यान—विषय था, वेदों में विनियोग प्रकरण। इस विषय पर प्रो. मिश्र ने सस्वर मन्त्रोच्चारण करते हुए कई उदाहरणों के विनियोग विधि को सरलतया स्पष्ट किया। एसोसिएट प्रो. मीना कुमारी ने अरण्यानि सूक्त का आधुनिक वनसंरक्षण विषय पर व्याख्यान प्रस्तुत किया। वेदसंस्थान के निदेशक, श्रीमान देवकृष्णदास द्वारा "लोकप्रचलित मान्यताओं से दिग्भ्रमित वेदव्याख्यान" विषय पर उदाहरण प्रस्तुत करते हुए व्याख्यान प्रस्तुत किया गया।

दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के प्रोफेसर एवं बृहत्तर वैदिक अध्ययन के महासचिव प्रो. रणजित बेहेरा द्वारा अन्तिम सत्र की अध्यक्षता की गयी। जिसमें कई शोधपत्र पढ़े गये। प्रो. बेहेरा ने सभी शोधविद्वानों के पत्रों की समीक्षा करते हुए सन्देश दिया कि वेदों का स्वाध्याय निरन्तर करते रहना चाहिए। वेद सभी विद्याओं के मूल हैं। विशेषकर उन्होंने सूर्य की व्युत्पत्ति निरुक्ति करते हुए अनेक उदाहरण प्रस्तुत किये।

इस सत्र में डॉ॰ प्रेम देवली, असिस्टेंट प्रोफेसर ने महर्षि अरिवन्द के वेदभाष्य, अरिवन्द की जीवन प्रक्रिया तथा उनकी कृतियों पर प्रकाश डाला। अन्य पत्र भी पढ़े। शोधपत्र के माध्यम



से वेद के विविध आयामों की चर्चा की। कुछ उल्लेखनीय नाम हैं–शोध–छात्र मनीष कुमार द्वारा ऋग्वेद में दान–सूक्तों का



महत्व प्रतिपादित किया गया। शोध छात्र पिन्टू कुमार द्वारा वेद में रसायन विज्ञान एवं शोध—छात्र देवराज द्वारा वेद में चिकित्सा पद्धति पर प्रकाश डाला गया।

शोधछात्रा चंदा द्वारा भी 'आधुनिक युग में यज्ञ' विषय पर विचार प्रस्तुत किये गये। "वेद संस्थान" एवं "बृहत्तर वैदिक अध्ययन परिषद्" के संयुक्त तत्त्वावधान में आयोजित की गयी एकदिवसीय वेदसंगोष्ठी में शोध—छात्रों ने उत्साहपूर्वक सोल्लास भाग लिया। श्रोताओं की दृष्टि में यह कार्यक्रम अत्यंत सफल रहा।



WAVES 2024 Webinar Series organized its Talk No. 5 Dr. Bhu Dev Sharma Memorial Lecture

BASIS AND PURPOSE OF SHRI RĀMA'S BIRTH

6th May 2024 Webinar: Talk No. 5

Dr. Aparna Dhir Khandelwal, Secretary, WAVES, India, moderated the program. The inaugural session commenced by playing the auspicious WAVES Kulgeet, "Vedādhyayana hai lakśya hamārā," to set a positive and uplifting atmosphere for the audience.

Dr. Bal Ram Singh, Scientist and Board Member of WAVES-USA, in his talk, provided a far and wide, comprehensive overview of the historical context, timeline, scientific, social, linguistic, and geographical aspects of Shri Rāma's life journey, emphasizing a logical and scientific approach to understanding the basis of his birth, the purpose of his life, and why we should uphold his values. Dr. Singh explored the jivan mulyas of Shri Rāma that make him a revered figure, bringing the concept of Rāma-Rajya. Dr. Singh emphasized that keeping one's word, as embodied by Shri Rāma, is the basis of science, enlightenment, and welfare for all. "Raghukula Riti sada chali Ai, Prana jahu, baru bachanu na jai" (Ayodhya Kand 27.4)



These concepts are well explained in Dr. Bal Ram Singh's book "A Different Take: An NRI View of India in the Tradition of Ram, Krishn and Gandhi"

In recognition of Dr. Bhu Dev Sharma's life journey, learned Professor Dr. S. Rama Rao Pappu was invited to offer his views on the given talk and the occasion. His association goes back to the founder of WAVES, Dr. Bhu Dev Sharma, from before the inception of the Academic Multidisciplinary Society. Prof. Pappu summed up his point: "Why is Râma popular? because he is a kind of moral exemplar, a paradigmatic individual. The lesson of Rāmāvana is what is possible to Rāma who is born like a human, suffered as a human, and that is possible for every other human being." This relates to Dr. Bal Ram Singh's finding that "Essentially, Ram does not have failures in life, despite many failures: Rājayābhisek, death of his father, Sītāharan, nāgpaś, inability to kill Rāvaņa, vanquishing of Sita."



Subsequently, the President of WAVES India, Prof. Shashi Tiwari delivered her insightful viewpoints. The topic for the talk was chosen by her, based on Dr. Bal Ram Singh's most recent article on the subject, which was published in the South Asian Times. She thanked Dr. Singh for giving the memorial talk and expressed Dr. Bhu Dev Sharma's strong relationship with WAVES International and WAVES India. She further emphasized the importance of this program being conducted jointly by both WAVES organizations. Regarding the talk, she focused on Dr. Singh's two significant findings, which basically inspired her to organize the talk.

She said, "All the stories which were given before the birth of Râma, especially in Tulsidasa's Ramcharitra Manas, stories about Shatrupa, Narad, Shravan Kumar, Jay Vijay... are all related to his birth, and because he takes birth, all these stories will be fulfilled." She further added that Dr. Bal Ram Singh remarkably manages to add the dimensions of time and space to these stories, which adds great value to the subject. Secondly, she

spoke on the topic of "Power," Shri Rāma was not seated on the throne of Ayodhyā when he killed Rāvaṇa and demolished his army of Rākśasas. Thus, Shri Rāma, without any worldly power, established Dharma, his purpose, and the reasons for his birth as Rāma.

Dr. Lallan Prasad, Former Professor of Business Economics at the University of Delhi, Board Member of WAVES India, and a close friend of Prof. Bhu Dev Sharma, was invited for his remarks on the program. He reflected on the talk: "In the present context, Shri Rāma's birth is relevant because of the purpose for which his birth happened; that purpose exists even today. Like the forthcoming avatār Kalki, which is set to fight the evil forces and remove them, this is the continuous process of History." In essence, the cause was Rāvaṇa, who threatened the Pṣ̄i and Dharmic followers, and thus, his destruction became the original purpose of Rāma's birth. This relates to the battle of good vs. evil, which has been going on since time immemorial.

Nearing the end of the program, Dr. Asha L. Panday, whose research area is Rāmāyaṇa, asked a question, which she described as a query that has been bothering her for a while: "Were the four brothers born at the same time? Prof. Lallan Prasad answered her question, "The answer lies in Valmiki Rāmāyaṇa; there was a time gap in their births; first came Rāma, then Bharat, Laxman and lastly, Úatrugan, their dates are not given."

Lastly, Dr. Aparna concluded the session and expressed collective gratitude on behalf of WAVES to all scholars and guests for their support and participation in the event, wishing the same for all future endeavors.

WHAT HAVE WE GAINED IN OUR QUEST TO KNOW INFINITY?

3rd June, 2024 Webinar : Talk No. 6

WAVES invited the renowned speaker Shri Rajiv Malhotra for the monthly webinar, where he gave a talk on the topic, 'What have we gained in our quest to know Infinity?' June 3, 2024

He has strong ties with WAVES as a philanthropist and expressed his ongoing interest in WAVES and its objectives.

In his 40s, he left the corporate world to pursue deep research. His quest resulted in a first-of-its-kind Think Tank on Hindu Thought known as the 'Infinity Foundation.' His journey spans thirty years and entails "the quest for infinity and applying that knowledge in the finite existence."

Mr. Malhotra spoke of having influential spiritual experiences, which led him to invest the rest of his life in investigating those experiences. Starting from funding related research at Harvard University and Jawaharlal Nehru University and discovering the deep bias that



hinders pure results, after a period of time, he, due to necessity, became a scholar, studying a wide spectrum from Indology and Shastras to Western thought, philosophy, religion, and politics. He established a school of thought by developing his way of thinking. Many volumes have been published, and many more are in the pipeline to establish "A Current Vedic School of Thought," rooted in Vedic Universalism: this, he asserted, is the new innovative thinking to resolve contemporary tribulations

He emphasized the depth of Vedic Knowledge: "It is vital to take into consideration the legacy of the Vedas. For instance, we recognize the need for a Vedic Framework for Al."

Further, he stated the three aims:

- 1) Knowledge: School of Thought, Research, Framework, and Discourse.
- 2) Human Resources: A team of Scholars and trained professionals to carry the 'Paramparâ forward to the Future.
- 3) Institutional Resources: Vedic-friendly Education, introducing Vedic Social Sciences in Universities.

At the end of the talk, Prof. Shashi Tiwari, President of WAVES, India, discussed with Mr. Malhotra the significance of the two theories he had developed.

- U-turn Theory, which explains the psychology of Westerners adopting and repurposing Hindu tradition, often without acknowledging the source.
- 2) The Being Different Theory insists on explaining why we are different and on accepting and preserving differences with mutual respect and understanding.

Prof. Tiwari described his book 'Being Different' as a thought-provoking and significant work for spreading knowledge.

One of the participants asked Mr. Malhotra about how it is possible to study AI in Silicon Valley through the Vedic Knowledge System.

"Machine learning takes experience, data, and an algorithm that keeps increasing. This is a certain model of neurology and neuroscience; it is called Neural Networks. Our Sânkhya theories—ideas of mind, intelligence, and memory—are a framework of mind and intelligence, which can be the backbone for machine learning. I am heavily invested in and writing on this topic; it's a huge topic." Mr. Malhotra responded.

Subsequently, Dr. Asha Lata Pandey requested Mr. Malhotra to elaborate on the various Frameworks, including Sanskrit's Non-translatability.

In his speech, he mentioned the terms 'Shakti' and 'Prana,' emphasizing that these words do not have precise English equivalents and that English lacks the concepts of mantras and vibrations, which are prevalent in Sanskrit Philosophy.

He stressed that each Sanskrit word has a purposeful sound and is not selected arbitrarily. Sanskrit's non-translatability is a Framework with its unique vocabulary, much like the 30 to 40 other Frameworks the Infinity Foundation has been evolving.

"The importance of Sanskrit is not even known by our people; they believe that it is just another language. We aim to offer a certificate course in Sanskrit focusing on the study of Sanskrit philosophy; we are seeking partnerships with organizations for collaboration." Mr. Malhotra announced.

Dr. Aparna Dhir Khandelwal, the moderator, concluded the session and expressed gratitude on behalf of WAVES to Mr. Malhotra and all the attendees for their support and active participation in the event.

THE TATTVAS AND THEIR POTENTIAL USE IN MODERN SCIENCE

1st July, 2024 Webinar : Talk No. 7

WAVES recently hosted Dr. Subhash Kak, a distinguished computer scientist, historian, and author who has been honored with the Padma Shri award, to lead their monthly webinar. During the webinar, Dr. Kak delivered a presentation on the topic of "The Tattvas and their Potential Use in Modern Science," exploring the practical application of the Tattvas in fields such as consciousness studies, neuroscience, and the development of cutting-edge technologies. The speaker provided valuable insights into how the Tattvas could inspire innovative solutions to complex problems.


Leading into the question of what consciousness is, he cited a line from the Kulgeet of the WAVES organization: "Take us from 'Apara' to 'Para." In the Vedic tradition, Apara represents knowledge of the outer world, including the physical realm and all embodiments.



Conversely, Para

knowledge relates to transcendent knowledge associated with the Atman, or consciousness. According to the Vedic perspective, these two forms of knowledge are complementary aspects of reality.

Dr. Kak articulated, "Consciousness is transcendent and lies at the core of the Vedas; it permeates like light, and there exists only 'One' consciousness." Additionally,



he conveyed that freedom is attained through becoming cognizant of consciousness and realizing one's identity as Atman-Brahman. "Atman is the microcosm, and Brahman is the entire cosmos, both in a reflexive relationship; this awareness is what separates a two-legged paœu from a four-legged paœu. Manas is how we operate through the world, but the anchor is the Atman."

The speaker emphasized that today's predominant focus on the body-centric or *Apara* view of reality, while not inherently wrong, is incomplete and has contributed to global confusion and delusion; when one thinks of oneself solely as a physical body, it becomes natural to view concepts like gender as interchangeable, challenging the foundation of traditional biological norms.

He then raised the question, "How can the concept of Consciousness get integrated with the mainstream science narrative and transform science?" Dr. Kak spoke of the limitations of mainstream science compared to the insights offered by Quantum Mechanics, aligning

with the Vedic tradition and recognizing consciousness as another aspect of reality. He also drew parallels between the Vedas and the Deepest Science. One profound insight is the Vedantic concept of 'Shristi Drishti Vada,' which asserts that creation occurred through observation. Quantum mechanics has challenged traditional scientific paradigms with phenomena like superposition and observer effects, echoing the notion that consciousness may indeed play a fundamental role in the evolution of the universe.

In his research, Dr. Kak discovered a synthesis between the 25 cognitive centers found in neuroscience and the 25 Tattvas in the *Sânkhya* system, which forms the foundation of the Vedic understanding of reality. Dr. Kak explained that "the *Akasa* Tattva, rather than simply representing space, is a vital element. In this 'E-dimensional' space, every point in physical and biological space is *Akashic*, constantly connected to every other element. *Akasa* serves as the medium of Consciousness in the Vedic model of the mind."

The basis of this theorem, as expressed by Dr. Kak, lies in the Brihadaranyaka Upanishad; in this text, the sage Yâjnavalkya tells Gargi: The *Tattvas* are all entangled; within *Vayu* is *Akasa*, *Akasa* is within Tejas, they are all within each other and not separate. This concept inspired Dr. Kak's research, marking the beginning of his eight-year journey into exploring these interconnected principles.

Following the conclusion of the presentation, the Chair of the program, Director, and Treasurer of WAVES-International expressed profound gratitude to Dr. Kak and then invited questions from the audience.

Renowned economist and academic Professor Lallan Prasad inquired, "Among the Five Tattvas, Akasa takes up the most space; it exists both within and outside the

body and throughout the entire Universe. Considering this, which Tattva came first?" Dr. Kak's response emphasized the complexity and ambiguity surrounding the concept of the primordial Tattva, particularly focusing on Akasa and its presence across different elements. "Just as sage Yajnavalkya said, Akasa is also present in the other tattvas. Therefore, if one analyzes the physical element - the Bhautik Tattva - as most Modern Sciences do, great insights can be extracted from there."

Dr. Shashi Tiwari, President of WAVES, India, praised Dr. Kak for delivering a 'thought-provoking' lecture and posed a question regarding Akasa. "In the Rigveda and other Vedas, various terms such as Duo, Swaha, and



Diva are used for Akasa. We commonly understand it as light space, and Antaraiksha as aerial space, and Prithavi as our space, where we can perceive things. What is the connection between Duo and Akasa?"

Dr. Kak, in his response, mentioned the correlation between the Five *Tattvas* and the Five *Indiras*. Additionally, he noted that *Prithavi* is connected to the sense of smell, while *Akasa* is associated with hearing. He clarified that *Akasa* is not directly linked to sound but rather to the message carried by the sound wave. Dr. Kak emphasized that transcendent knowledge is conveyed through Akasa, serving as the medium through

which *Jivatman* or *Manus* connects with the Higher 'Cosmic' Reality. However, he highlighted the need for further examination of this matter.

After the engaging Q&A session, Shri Dhirendra A. Shah officially announced the dates for the upcoming 'WAVES 2024' conference at the Hindu University of America (HUA), Orlando, Florida, September 13-15. Dr. Kak is set to present his paper aligning with the conference theme. Concluding the webinar, Dr. Aparna Dhir Khandelwal, the moderator, expressed gratitude on behalf of WAVES to Dr. Kak and all the attendees for their unwavering support and active participation.

Overall, the webinar was highly interactive, with a knowledgeable audience of scholars and academics actively participating. Attendees posed thought-provoking questions to Dr. Kak. The session facilitated a rich exchange of ideas and insights. Several attendees shared their sincere thoughts following the event:
